Year 2 (Diploma Part 1) Tuesdays, 3 terms of 8 weeks plus 1 Saturday seminar each term:
Term 1: 25/10–13/12 plus 5 November; Term 2: 31/1–20/3 plus 4 February; Term 3: 8/5–26/6 plus 9 June.

How to enrol: You can enrol at any time by filling out a form online at www.londonschoolofastrology.co.uk, and sending a cheque/credit card details by post, or paying with PayPal (using our email address), or calling the office on 0700 2 33 44 55 (Mon–Fri office hours) to pay by card. Please note: our BCM box can take up to 7 days to deliver letters. If you have not heard from us by 7–10 days after booking, please follow up with a call to our office. You may choose to pay on a term-by-term basis or make a saving by paying for 2 or 3 terms together.

Late entry onto courses: We advise students to join at the beginning of the course, but those with some experience may enrol in Term 2 (early February) or Term 3 (early May). It is always worth telephoning the LSA office for advice on this – or calling us to discuss any aspect of your studies.

Open Evening – Thursday 6 October

Our free, no-obligation Open Evening is for those wishing to discover more about our school and courses. It takes place on Thursday 6 October from 7pm to 8.15pm. There will be a short talk on astrology and a chance to meet tutors and ask questions. It is open to all and is held at Friends Meeting House, 173 Euston Road, London NW1 2BJ (directly opposite Euston Station).

Year 1: Our Foundation Course (three 8-week terms plus 1 Saturday seminar per term)

Learn the tools and ‘language’ of Astrology: the zodiac signs, planets, aspects and houses; work on your own chart and horoscopes of people in the news, and start to spot and synthesize major chart themes. Suitable for newcomers or those wishing to refresh their knowledge or fill in the gaps, this popular course provides a firm grounding of astrological principles. (The Sun-Moon cycle, nodes, Chiron, the Void Moon, retrogradation and basic astronomy are also on the syllabus.)

Years 2 and 3: Our Diploma Course (three 8-week terms plus 1 Saturday seminar per term)

This course will help you develop your skills and become fluent and confident in interpretation and forecasting. You’ll also learn tools that are essential for today’s working astrologer: Locational (astro-maps), Electional, Vocational, Mundane and Horary, plus Synastry (relationship compatibility), ethics and consultancy with live client sessions. Gain a working knowledge of forecasting methods such as transits, directions, progressions, returns, the Huber Clock and Lunar Gestation Cycle.

Monthly Seminars and Special Events

We offer a number of one-off classes and special events, such as our **Palmistry Conference**, as well as regular Saturday seminars, which form part of the LSA course but are open to all.

Lecturers in recent years have included Deborah Houlding, Bernadette Brady, Tracy Marks and Dennis Elwell, while Liz Greene, Alan Oken and Shelley von Strunckel have spoken at our annual **Astrology Student Conference (ASC)**, a weekend of themed talks and discussions. The next ASC will take place on 21–22 April 2012.

Tarot and Palmistry Courses (Mondays)

Our 8-week Palmistry Course with Frank Clifford (author of *Palmistry 4 Today*) runs from November. It’s a practical course designed to explore easy, immediate and memorable ways to read hands. Students will study various prints from Frank’s files and be encouraged to compile their own collection. The course is now available by distance learning (which includes online/phone tutorials with Frank).

In Spring 2012 we are running another Tarot Beginners’ Course with Sue Farebrother, a gifted teacher and reader in the field. It’ll be a comprehensive 8-week course (with notes and assignments) for absolute beginners and those wishing to revise the subject.
